Pretoria West power station is a coal-fired power plant with a total capacity of 180 MW. The plant was built in 1952, and is owned by Tshwane Electricity Division.

Where is Pretoria West coal power station South Africa located?

Pretoria West Coal Power Station South Africa is located at Pretoria, Gutang, SA. Location coordinates are: Latitude= -25.75839, Longitude= 28.14667. This infrastructure is of TYPE Coal Power Plant with a design capacity of 180 MWe. It has 6 unit (s). The first unit was commissioned in 1952 and the last in 1952.

How many power plants are there in South Africa?

South Africa has 104 utility-scale power plants in operation, with a total capacity of 50422.7 MW. A joint venture (JV) of Exxaro Resources and Tata Power Cennergi is the owner and developer of the wind farm. This data is a derivative set of data gathered by source mentioned below.

Could Tshwane get a solar power plant?

The general manager of Eskom real estate sought to connect Tshwane with companies that could lease the two power stations' land and operate as Independent Power Producers. The Pretoria West and Rooiwal sites reportedly had "strong potential" for both solar and gas projects.


