Overview

What is the largest solar energy project in Libya?

In June 2022, Total Energies, in collaboration with the General Electricity Company of Libya (GECOL) and REAoL, launched the Sadada Solar Energy 500 MW project in Al-Sadada, which is set to become the largest of its kind in the country.

What are Libya's planned solar projects?

Libya's planned solar projects align with the government's National Strategy for Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency, which outlines plans to achieve 4 GW of combined solar and wind capacity by 2035. Construction of the TotalEnergies-led solar plant project is expected to commence from 2025.

Could Libya be a solar energy exporter?

The desert technology (DESRT-TEC) is one of the largest projects; there was proposed that Libya would be one of the exporters of solar power generated from solar energy to Europe (Griffiths, 2013). The aims of that project to provide Europe Union countries with energy generated from the sun in North Africa and the Middle East countries.

How much solar energy will Libya generate a year?

The project is being developed in collaboration between TotalEnergies, REAOL, and the General Electricity Company of Libya and is poised to generate approximately 152 TWh of solar energy per year.
